Isabelle “Izzy” Helmke



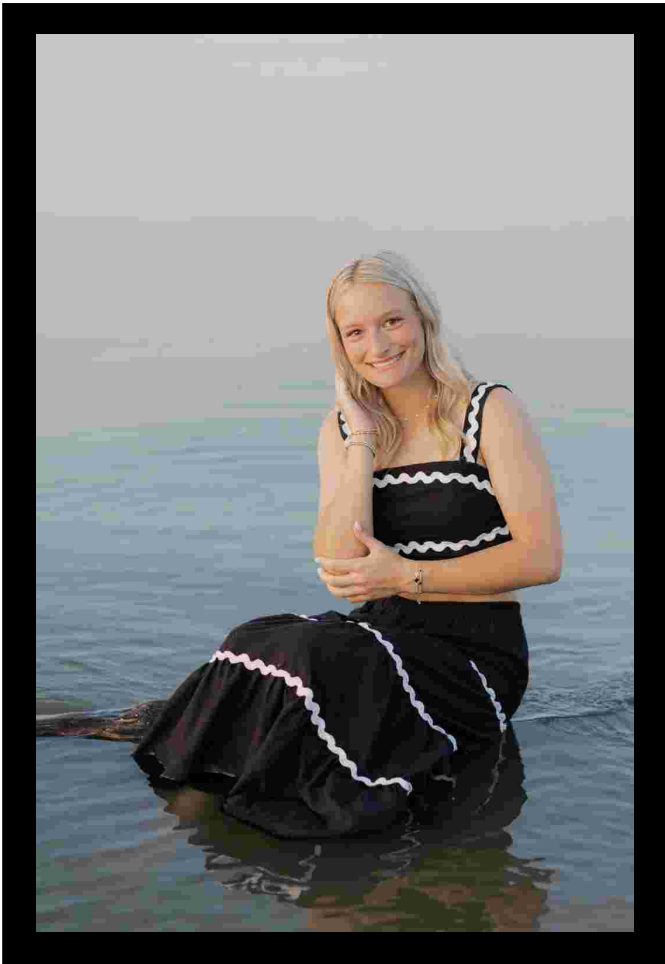
